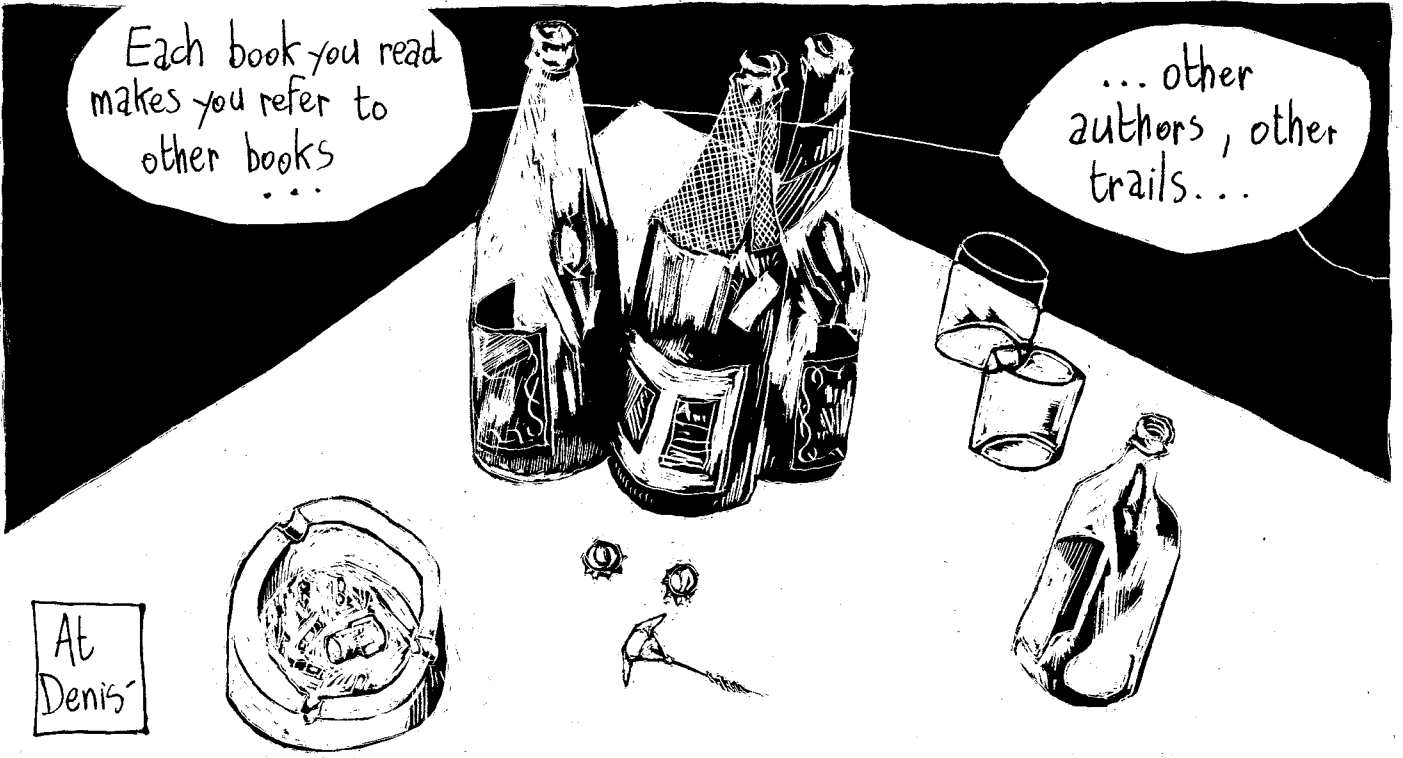

Each book you read makes you refer to other books ...

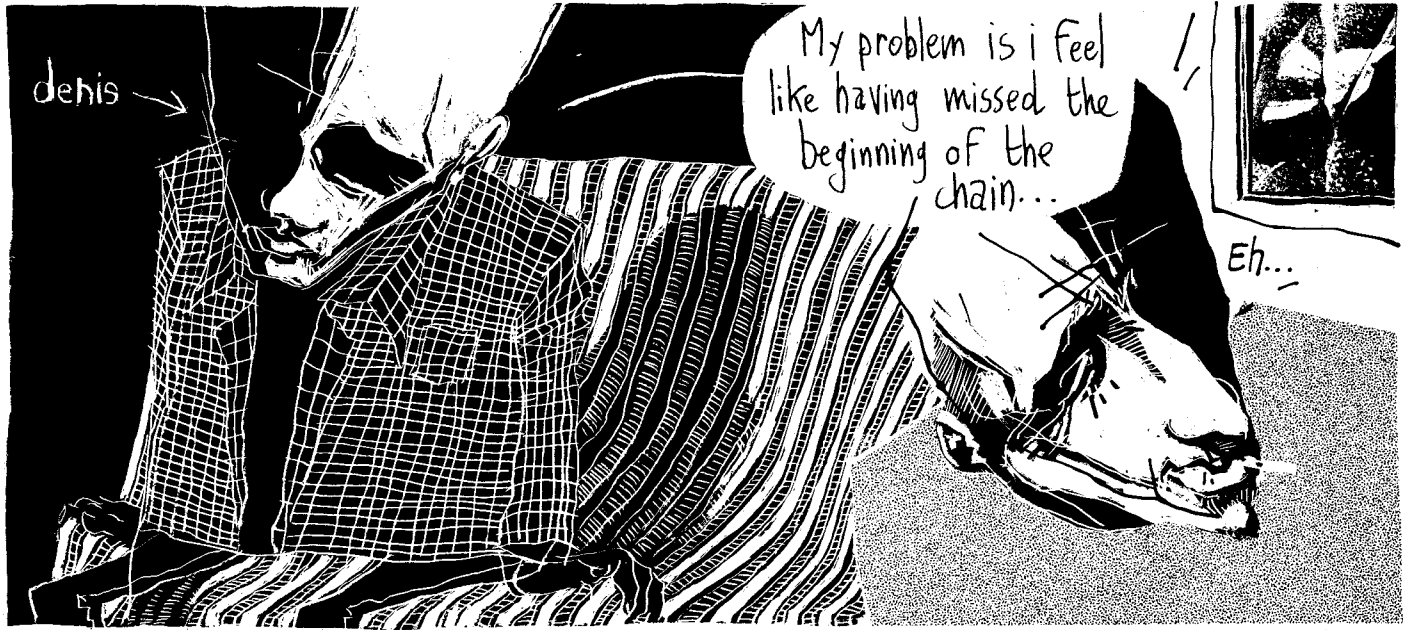
... other authors, other trails...

... as if you walked along a never ending chain...

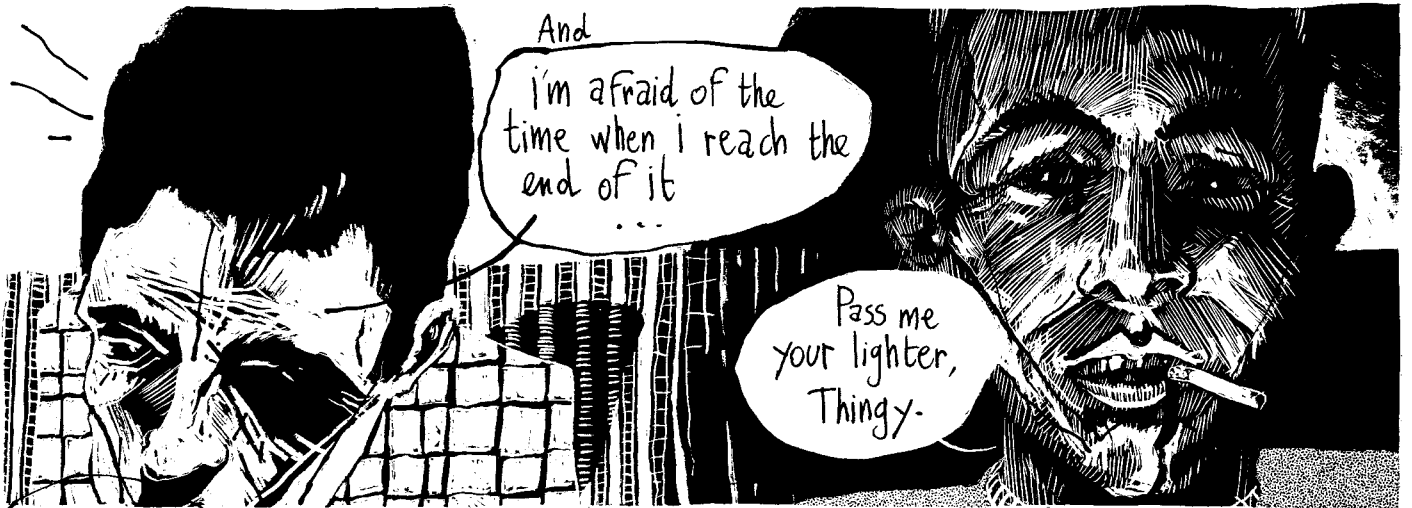

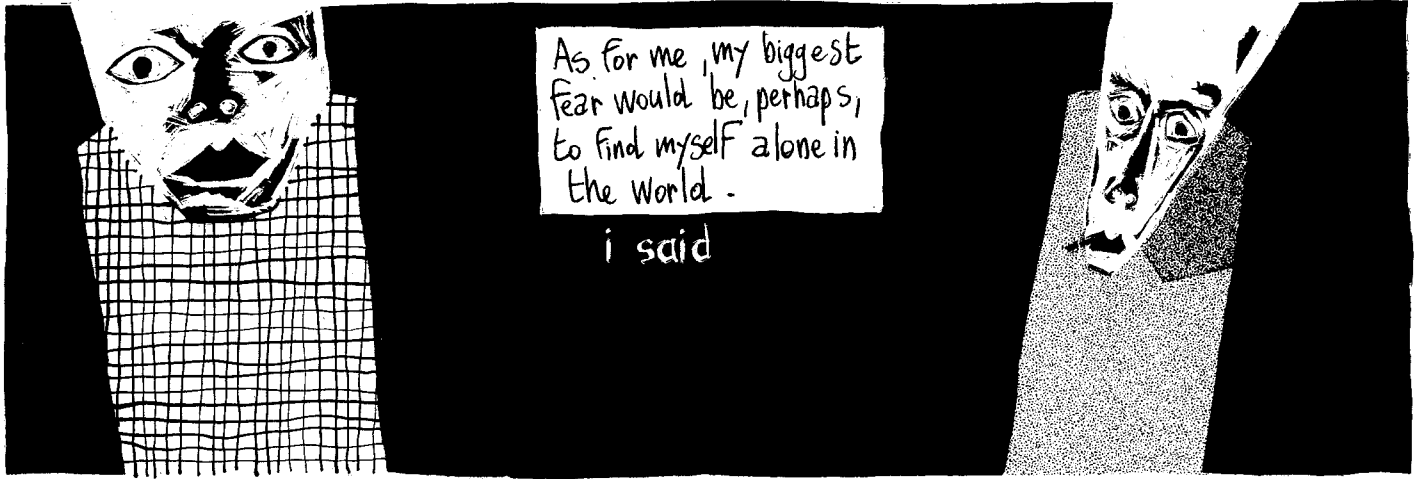
Prehistory,
